4C MATHS EXHIBITION HOLIDAY HOMEWORK

Volunteers Count — And So Does Maths!

To celebrate International Year of Volunteers for Sustainable Development, take any state (e.g., Kerala, UP, Tamil Nadu) and pick one SDG goal (e.g., SDG 13 Climate, SDG 6 Water etc.) to show volunteer maths for clean rivers, trees, and solar power.

1. Measure Mission Masters -(Roll no. 1-8)

3D model of state volunteers planting trees, integrating measurement (tree heights), shapes (rectangular planters), graphs (weekly trees), basic calculations to show carbon saved (SDG 13).

2. Graph Guardians-(Roll 9-16)

Pictorial placard (half cardboard) showing state river clean-up: Use multiplication for total plastic bags collected by volunteers over days (SDG 14). Include a pie chart of waste types.

3. Shape Squad-(Roll no.17-24)

Poster focused on state with numerical data (trees planted), geometric shapes (circular gardens), line graphs (waste reduction), fun facts about volunteer impact (SDG 15).

4. Sum Saviours (Roll no.25-32)

Board game/maze on half cardboard where players solve addition (volunteers + tools), subtraction (trash - recycled) to reach sustainable goal (SDG 6).

5. Timeline Titans (Roll no.-33-40)

Chart showing shapes in state volunteer work (semi-circles tree pits, rectangles bins) OR timeline using subtraction (forest size changes over decades, SDG 15).

6. Maths Rangoli-Wizards (Roll no.-41-47)

Rangoli design with symmetrical patterns (mirror trees), number grids (add to target), geometric borders (circles = recycling bins) using green/blue colours (SDG 12).

7. Wall Hanging Heroes (Rollno.47-51)

Wall hanging with dangling shapes (triangles solar panels, rectangles bins) showing volunteer calculations (clean-ups \times volunteers = total hours served, SDG 7).

CLASS 4 E– SCIENCE Exhibition HOMEWORK

Dear Students,

In 2026, the world celebrates the power of volunteers who help us achieve the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). For your exhibition homework, you will show how volunteers change our community.

Group A

Make a 3D model that shows the power of volunteers .

1. Left Side – BEFORE

Show a dirty, neglected park. Include: dry plants, litter like wrappers, broken bench, sad faces of people. Use brown paper for mud, real dry leaves, pencil shavings as trash.

2. Right Side – AFTER

Show the same park after volunteers worked there. Include: volunteers wearing gloves, dustbins, watering cans, new plants. Show a clean park with green trees, flowers, and happy kids playing.

Important Details

1. **Label:** Put small labels – “BEFORE” and “AFTER”. Add an arrow between them that says “Volunteers”.
2. **SDG Link:** In the “AFTER” side, draw or paste small logos of any 2 SDGs. Example: SDG 11 Sustainable Cities, SDG 15 Life on Land

GROUP B

Make a poster showing how the volunteers help in achieving the SDG goals.

Important instructions

1. Use an A3 sheet
2. Choose any one SDG goal and show how volunteers can help in achieving it.
3. Few examples are-
SDG 2 Zero hunger
SDG 3 Good health and well being
SDG 5 Gender equality

You can search for more and then make a poster.

We are going to celebrate **International Year of VOLUNTEERS FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT (2026-27)**.

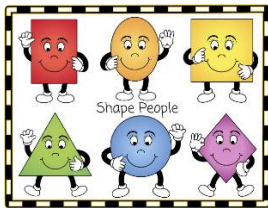
We want to raise awareness about the Volunteers who work together to build a nation to keep clean and green Earth. In lieu of that, students are assigned various tasks as per their roll nos.
