Do not use thermocol plates. Please use paper plates only.

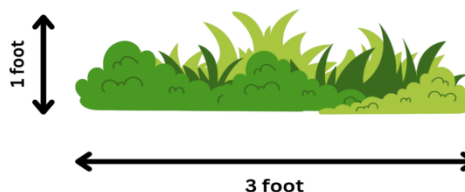
If a paper plate is not available, you can use thick cardboard or any box board of circular shape
