Why are we doing this?

Instructions:

1. Cut the Strips:

Take any colored paper and cut long strips about 2 inches wide and 12 inches long. These will be the base or "stems" for your flowers.

3. Assemble the Strings:

Glue the flowers along the strip to create a beautiful pattern. You can decorate with leaves or designs if you like.

4. Add a Hanging Loop:

Attach a loop at the top of the strip so you can hang your flower string.

5. Make 5 Strings:

Submit five completed flower strings filled with creativity and bright colors.
