**School Timings of the New Session:**

**7:55A.M. – 2:00 P.M. (Mon- Fri) -Van & Self Commuters will disperse at 1:50P.M.**

**7:55 A.M – 12:15 P.M. (I, III & V Saturdays)**

**Parent –School Interface:**

- DAV Pushpanjali believes that Parental involvement is a cornerstone in a child's education. It can make a considerable difference to your child's school life, both in academic success and in general progress at school. Thus, attending regular PTMs and meeting teachers for updates on your wards progress is important.
- Almanac and Academic plans are issued to the students and they should be read thoroughly for effective reference. Fill all the required details in the almanac.

**Discipline Guidelines:**

- A school is known and recognized by the discipline that is reflected in the behavior of its students, therefore a strict but also a child friendly regime is followed in our school.
- Our School Almanac lists a Code of Conduct about appropriate student behavior, as well as procedures for disciplinary action. The Code is designed to emphasize the importance of creating safe, welcoming school environment that supports student learning and promotes their personality development.
- Unnecessary fights, bullying and violence is unacceptable.
- Any form of substance abuse, gutka, cigarette, vape, alcohol etc. is banned in the school campus.
- Use of abusive language is also prohibited at the school campus.

### **Transportation Related Instructions:**

- With regard to pick and drop of your ward parents may avail school bus facility or have own arrangements (please do update the details of vans, drivers etc. for proper vigilance of vans)
- Parents should not bring their vehicles in the school premises while dropping and picking their wards and on PTM days vehicles should be parked at Parwana Road.
- While entering the school premises it is mandatory to submit Mobiles at the school gate.
- It is very important that while entering the school premises parents must come appropriately dressed to maintain the decorum of school premises.
- In case of private arrangement to drop you ward through vans, or personal vehicles, please ensure that they reach between 7.30 A.M. to 7.55 A.M. No student should reach school before 7.30 A.M. and avoid being late also.
- Private vehicles, school vans cause inconvenience to residents of the area so your ward should be dropped at Parwana Road – Pushpanjali Enclave Gate no-6, Near Guru Nanak School ONLY by the van drivers.
- In the morning arrival time, vehicles will be allowed to ONLY enter from the market Gate and will exit from the Parwana Road gate. No one will be allowed to reverse or turn back on this track and E-rickshaw and school vans will not be permitted, except in exempted cases.
- Please send your ward in proper school uniform with Identity cards and PT dress should be worn on designated days only.
- Do not allow your child to drive motor cycles, scooty, cars etc.
- Your ward should not wear any expensive jewelry or bring any gadget esp. mobiles to the school. If mobiles are required then it must be deposited with Class Teacher in the morning.
- We regularly advise you to take care of the health and hygiene of your child especially nails, hair styles so that they showcase the grace of a well-groomed student.

### **New Uniform**

- DAV CMC has introduced new uniform pan India from this new session. Parents are requested to buy the same and send their wards well dressed, neat and tidy to the school. A Grace period of 2 years are given to gradually change to the new uniform.

### **Integrated Sports Programme :**

The most apparent advantage of incorporating sports into the curriculum is the promotion of physical health and wellness. Students learn to set goals, manage their time effectively, and develop discipline. The challenges faced in the sports field translate into valuable life lessons, fostering resilience and perseverance. Team work and interpersonal skills while playing are transferred to various aspects of life, preparing students for success in both personal and professional spheres.
