#### **EXHIBITION WORK (GROUP PROJECT)**

- Roll No. 1-11: Create a model showcasing glaciers before global warming and after it to highlight the factors affecting glaciers and their ecosystems.
- Roll No. 12- 23: Develop a 2 meter photo reel (hardcopy) showcasing the majestic beauty of glaciers and highlighting their significance in maintaining Earth's climate and freshwater resources.
- Roll No. 24-35: Craft 2 models (clay/paper mache) representing animals and plants that inhabit glacial regions, such as snow leopards, polar bears, and alpine flowers. Use these masks to educate visitors about the species' adaptations to cold environments.
- Roll No. 36-47: Create a 2D/3D model that reflects the delicate balance of ecosystems supported by glaciers. Emphasize themes like water cycles, climate stability, and the interconnectedness of life.
