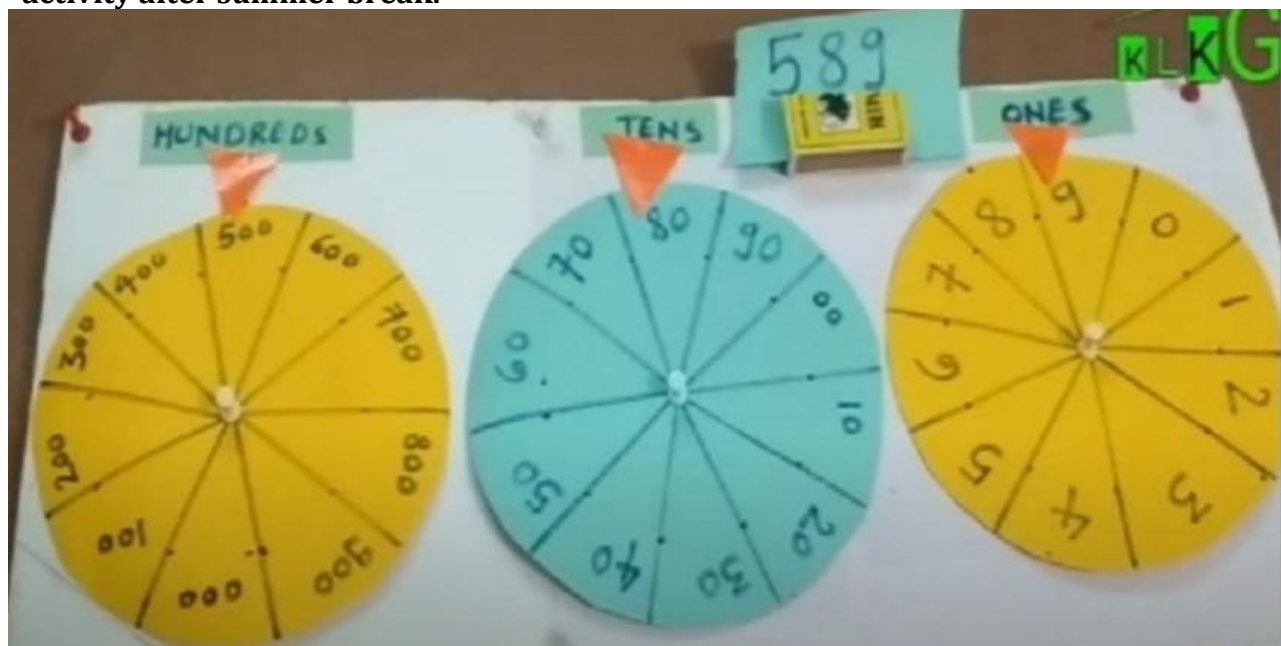

“To find the treasure, you must solve 7 challenges hidden across Numberland. Each challenge unlocks a clue to the treasure’s location!”

Misha packed her bag with a pencil, notebook, magnifying glass, and set off...

CHALLENGE 1: THE TALKING TREES OF TALLY FOREST

In the forest, trees had numbers carved on them: **348, 215, 602, 499, 703**

Task:

- Write the **number names** of each tree.

- Circle the tree with the **smallest number**.
- Underline the tree with the **largest number**.
- Arrange them in **ascending order**.

CHALLENGE 2: THE PLACE VALUE RIVER

To cross the river, Misha had to answer questions from the wise old turtle.

Task:

- Take the number **348** and break it into **hundreds, tens, and ones**.
- Do the same for: **215, 703, 499**
- Then write the **expanded form** of each.

Example:

$$348 = 300 + 40 + 8$$

CHALLENGE 3: THE PUZZLE BRIDGE

The bridge was full of puzzles! Misha had to solve them to pass.

Task:

1. What number comes **before and after**:
 - 215
 - 703
 - 499
2. Find a number that is **between**:
 - 348 and 352
 - 600 and 604

CHALLENGE 4: THE GIANTS OF GREATER & SMALLER

Two number giants stood blocking the path. One only lets you pass if you solve comparisons correctly.

Task:

Use **>**, **<**, **or =** to compare:

1. 348 703
2. 215 215
3. 602 499
4. 703 370
5. 348 384

CHALLENGE 5: THE CAVE OF PATTERNS

Inside a dark cave, glowing numbers lit up in patterns.

Task:

Continue the number patterns:

1. 310, 312, 314, , ,
2. 800, 805, 810, , ,
3. 101, 103, 105, , ,

Now create **your own 3-digit pattern** and write the next 3 numbers.

CHALLENGE 6: THE TREASURE SHOPKEEPER

Misha met a friendly merchant guarding the treasure map.

Task:

She wanted to buy:

- A golden key – Rs. **37**
- A magical torch – Rs. **21**
- A treasure map – Rs. **18**

She had Rs. **80**

- Find the **total cost** of her items.
- How much money will be **left** after shopping?
- Can she buy an **extra sword for Rs. 5**? Why or why not?

FINAL CHALLENGE: THE TREASURE LOCK

The treasure chest had a code lock. The code was a mystery number!

Clues:

- It's a 3-digit number
- Hundreds digit is 5
- Ones digit is 3
- The sum of all digits is 11

Task:

What is the number? Write its:

- **Number name**
- **Expanded form**
- **Before and after**

My Bio Enzyme

Objective: To learn about waste management, fermentation, and eco-friendly cleaning by making a natural bio enzyme at home using fruit peels.

What is Bio Enzyme?

Bio enzyme is a natural cleaner made by fermenting fruit peels with sugar and water. It can be used to clean floors, bathrooms, and even water plants!

What You Need:

- 1 part jaggery (or brown sugar)
- 3 parts citrus fruit peels (orange, lemon, sweet lime, etc.)
- 10 parts water
- A clean plastic bottle or container with a lid (transparent is best)
- A spoon, funnel, and marker
- A notebook for observations

Steps to Follow:

1. **Collect peels** of citrus fruits like oranges, lemons, or sweet limes.
2. **Wash and cut** them into small pieces.
3. **Mix** jaggery/sugar, fruit peels, and water in the 1:3:10 ratio.
4. **Pour** the mixture into a plastic bottle, leaving some space at the top.
5. **Label** the bottle with your name and date.
6. **Loosen the cap** daily for the first 2 weeks to release gas (important!).
7. **Shake the bottle** gently every day.
8. After 30-45 days, **strain the liquid** — this is your **bio enzyme**!

Bonus Stars:

- Use recycled materials for your container or journal.
- Try making two different types (e.g., lemon vs orange) and compare!
